Harold E. Spangler, born 12/31/21 at East Berlin, PA. Enlisted in 1942 and attended Cadet Pilot training in Southeast Training Command. Completed B-17 training and assigned to 15th AAF, 301st Bomb Group (Heavy), Foggia, Italy, June 1944. Flew Squadron and Group lead as a Flight Commander. Completed full combat tour in March 1945 and returned to USA. Resigned active duty August 1945. Worked for the Navy until June 1950 when application for recall to active duty resulted in duty similar to Navy duties with assignment at Air Material Command, Wright Patterson AFB, OH. June 1952 assigned to 17th Bomb Group, Korea as Staff Supply Officer and flew C-47's as duty pilot. December 1953 assigned to Cambridge Research Center, as Administrative Contracting Officer, Lincoln Laboratory, MIT. Continued in Research and Development Command as a Procurement Inspector from September 1956 to December 1960 with extensive travel to interesting places such as Cape Canaveral and Edwards AFB, etc. January 1960 assigned to Air Material Area, Pacific, at Tachikawa, Japan as a Termination Contracting Officer until December 1962. At Rome Air Material Area served as Chief, Management Services-Procurement and as Base Procurement Officer until retirement September 1968. Flew Allegheny Commuter for two years. Served small business as a Consultant for 17 years.
